

Per virtue of its peer-to-peer, distributed architecture, the network is resilient to external influence.




As little as a phone and an internet connection is enough to use the system.



A scarce digital asset, with a predictable and finite supply







Adoption As a Financial Asset: The Balance Sheet Trade
















