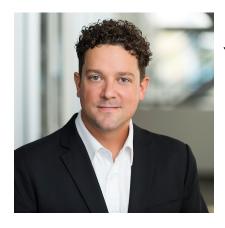

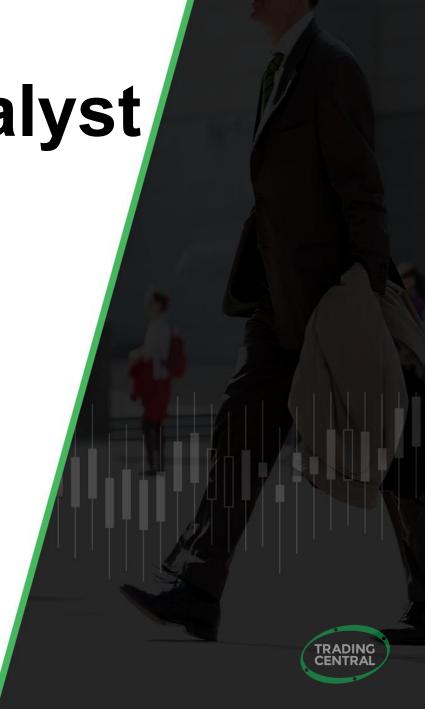

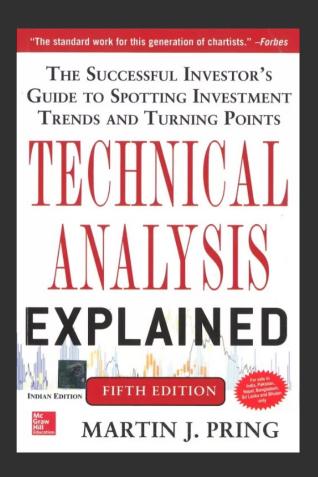
What is Technical Analysis
