- Digital Asset reporting (Cryptocurrency)
 - Required reporting which was set to being for 2023 has been delayed
 - Decline in value is not eligible for loss deduction
 - FTX Trading Ltd. Chapter 11 bankruptcy
 - Cryptocurrency is NOT a security different rules apply
 - Tax treatment is evolving
 - Don't forget to answer the question concerning Cryptocurrency ownership/trading on the 1040.
