Market Climate

- Market Climate can be seen as the current Market Environment
- Some Market characteristics tend to last offering...
 - ...potentially higher probability Trades
 (adding odds to our Trading method reduces the amount of times when a Market shows unexpected behavior)
 - ...longer lasting Trades

 (exposing our Trades to longer Market movements helps to maximize the size of the Profits to be made)



Respecting The Climate

Expected Higher Success Rate:

Trading in a way that is aligned with market momentum should increase success chances.

Expected Lower Risk:

Thanks to tighter stop losses as the impulses should occur in the Climate direction.

Momentum Advantage:

Riding the Climate should have an impact on R:R ratios.

Less Stress:

Less emotionally taxing and reduces overtrading.

• Clearer Signals:

Potentially clearer entry and exit signals.



Not Assessing The Climate

Lower Success Rate:

Trades may be initiated against the market momentum.

Higher Risk:

Wider stop losses to absorb impulse volatility and avoid unnecessary stop-outs.

Limited Profits:

Targets become achievable when located closer to entry hurting the R:R ratios.

More Stress:

Seeing price move and reverse can be emotionally challenging.

• False Signals:

Less clear entries/exits, leading to errors.



Market Characteristics

Here are some key Market characteristics:

- Market Trends: Refer to current overall direction which could be Up or Down or simply horizontal within a Range
- Market Sustainability: Refers to the amount of distance and time spent travelling in a specific direction and therefore the likelihood of this condition to remain or change
- Market Volatility: Refers to the speed of Price movement

In a proper Trading Methodology, these Market characteristics dictate what a Trader should do: Going Long or Going Short or avoiding Trading
