Cboe Global Markets (CBOE) reported record-breaking trading volumes for February 2025. The company achieved an alltime high U.S. Options Average Daily Volume (ADV) of **18.0 million contracts** across its four U.S. options exchanges, including a record multiply-listed options ADV of 13.6 million and S&P 500 Index (SPX) options ADV of 3.5 million contracts.



Options Market Volume

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Example 1: Corporate Bond Puts Exploded in March



- On March 13th, there was the second largest volume of puts traded on HYG in the past ten years.
- Does someone know something major? Are we facing a large credit market issue?
- Based on the volume traded alone, it looked like smart money may be betting on a big drop.

At this moment - without understanding options - what do you do?

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Example 1: Bank Analysts Panicked - We Analyzed Flows



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Example 2: The S&P 500 Dropped - Then Flatlined



There was no news or fundamental reason for this intraday drop

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Example 3: The S&P 500 Dropped - Then Ripped Upward



There was again no fundamental news behind the move - what was the driver?

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In Both Cases, Monthly Options Expired - Like Clockwork



Without options expertise, how can you tell when moves may flatline or reverse?



Example 4: Ceiling and Floor Identified - Positional Analysis



"The SPX is showing net positive gamma strike support <5,500 from traders selling puts (dealers long). In between there we have that one massive 3/31 exp JPM strike (5,565), then to the upside the "Last strike standing" is a large 5,700 positive gamma call (dealers long, max upside target into OPEX)."

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
Example 4: Ceiling and Floor Identified - Positional Analysis




Over the next two weeks, SPX stayed within the 5500 <> 5700 range

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Example 5: April 7 Brought Extreme Volatility



Deeply negative gamma between 410 -430 indicated **heightened volatility** throughout this range



SpotGamma Gamma Model flagged **425 as a key level** for April 7th, as options would drive QQQ to revert or pin here




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Example 5: April 7 Brought Volatility - QQQ Levels Held



Price moved violently - until stabilizing just below 425




